### The "BIG 4" in order of (Danish Wadden Sea) relevance:

- 1 Natura 2000 directives (Birds (1979) & Habitats (1992))
- 1 Marine Strategy Framework Directive (2008)
- 2 Maritime Spatial Planning Directive (2014)
- 2 Water Framework Directive (2000)

The "+" added to the BIG-4

#### **NOTE** that


- the Danish coast line > 7700 km
- the Danish Wadden Sea coast line < 200 km

#### **BASICALLY**

The Danish Wadden Sea is protected and managed by the "BIG-4" like all other Danish marine areas

#### **NONETHELESS**

The Danish Wadden Sea has it's very own protection regime: "Statutory Order on conservation and game reserve in the Wadden Sea"



Executive Order on conservation and game reserve in the Wadden Sea

- 1<sup>st</sup> edition in 1985 (following the "Copenhagen Declaration" in 1982)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> edition in 1998
- 3<sup>rd</sup> edition in 2007
- 4<sup>th</sup> edition in progress (2021?)

### Executive Order on conservation and game reserve in the Wadden Sea" concerns restrictions/prohibitions regarding:

- Traffic
- Hunting
- Uptake of organisms above and below the seabed
- Miscellaneous measures:
  - construction works,
  - coastal protection facilities,
  - dredging material sites,
  - excavation for raw materials, etc.,
  - release of plants and animals,
  - waste,
  - power lines and wind turbines

- > N2000
- > MSFD
- > WFD
- > MSPD

### N2000 in Denmark & the Danish Wadden Sea

- (Baseline analysis)
- Targets & Measures





### **N2000 focus in Denmark**

### 2016-2021 i.a.:

- Coherence in nature
- Habitats for breeding birds
- Control of invasive species

2022-2027:

Not yet officially established

- Natura 2000-plan (Targets and measures)
- Consultation Note
- Summary Statement
  Strategic Environmental Assessement of the Plan Proposal
- Baseline analysis

### N2000 plan N89 for The Danish Wadden Sea Programme of measures

- 7 general measures
- 9 specific measures

### Implementation:

It is a joint task for municipalities and public landowners to agree in more detail on which areas and in which municipalities the specific measures are to take place.

# Marine Strategy Framework Directive (MSFD) in Denmark





### **MSFD** in Denmark

- Ecosystem-based approach
- 11 descriptors →
- Holistic assessment cycles
- Regional coordination, OSPAR (and HELCOM) strategi(es)




















### MSFD in Denmark: Areas covered by the Marine Strategy



MSFD in Denmark: Most significant pressure factors in the Danish part of the North Sea (& the Wadden Sea)

- 1) Nutrients
- 2) Alien species
- 3) Fishing
- 4) Environmentally hazardous substances
- 5) Noise

Conclusion from EU-Commission: Better (regional) coordination of monitoring and action programs, more ambitious goals for regional cooperation. -> Update of MSFD in 2017

Regional cooperation etc. most successfully done in "the North East Atlantic" area


Water Framevork Directive (WFD) in Denmark

### WFD in Denmark

- Deals with biology and chemistry in inland streams, lakes and coastal waters.
- Coastal waters quality elements: Eelgrass (depth limits), chlorofyl-a & benthic fauna (Danish Quality Index)
- Chemistry most relewant for marine areas
- Migrating freshwater fish also relewanf WFD "stuff", particulary in the Wadden Sea
- In DK MSFD takes over from the coastline and not from the 3 NM line (monitoring and measures)

# Marine Spatial Planning Directive (MSPD) in Denmark

### MSPD in Denmark: NATURE AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ZONES





### MSPD in Denmark building on 5 elements:

- Ecosystem-based approach
- Spaciousness
- Inclusion of best available knowledge
- Coexistence
- The interaction between land and sea

Who's legally obliged to do what in Denmark with regard to the BIG-4+?

# Legal consequences of the BIG-4 management plans and the "Statutary Order" in Denmark

BIG-4: Only mandatory/binding for public authorities, i.e. government & municipalities, no decisions/permits must endanger the state of nature.


Statutary Order: Universally mandatory/binding, also for citizens etc.

A way forward

### Protecting the Wadden Sea, a way forward

- 1. Based on the MSFD, EU encourages "regional cooperation" based on the 4 regional conventions aiming at protecting the seas, and within those to coordinate "subregional":
  - 1. HELCOM
  - 2. OSPAR
  - 3. Mediteranian
  - 4. Black Sea
- 2. Specifically working with and further develop Marine Protected Areas (MPA)
